The Route: The tour begins and ends in Tremont Village Park, Route 9 in Tremont Illinois. The route will travel through Central Illinois on paved and lightly traveled roads. The terrain is flat to rolling hills, marked with white painted arrows on the road surface. A map will be provided to each rider.

Food: All registered riders will be offered refreshments and drinks along the mapped route. Stops will include Tremont, Deer Creek, Jellystone Park-Goodfield, Mackinaw, and few country spots in between towns. Fruit, doughnuts, coffee, and water will be provided prior to the tour. A lunch style meal will be provided upon the conclusion of the rider. Lunch will be served at the Tremont Village Park.

Support Vehicles: Support vehicles will patrol the route to assist/rides to cyclists in need.

Entry Fees: Individual fee is \$15.00. Family fee for three or more is \$35.00. (\$5.00 fee is assessed if registration payment is not received prior to August 1, 2011. Please make checks payable to Triangle of Opportunity and send to PO Box 651, Minier, IL, 61759. Proceeds to benefit the Triangle Student Scholarship and rural economic development.

Registration: Please complete the form below and mail to the specified address. On the morning of the tour (Saturday, August 6) please plan to arrive between 7:00 am – 8:00 am to sign. At the conclusion of the tour, please sign out at the same location (Tremont Village Park). If the entrant is under 15 years of age, he/she must be accompanied by an adult throughout the ride. If the entrant is under 18 years of age, he/she must have an entry form signed by parent or guardian. Helmets are mandatory. Tour is a rain or shine event (no refunds). 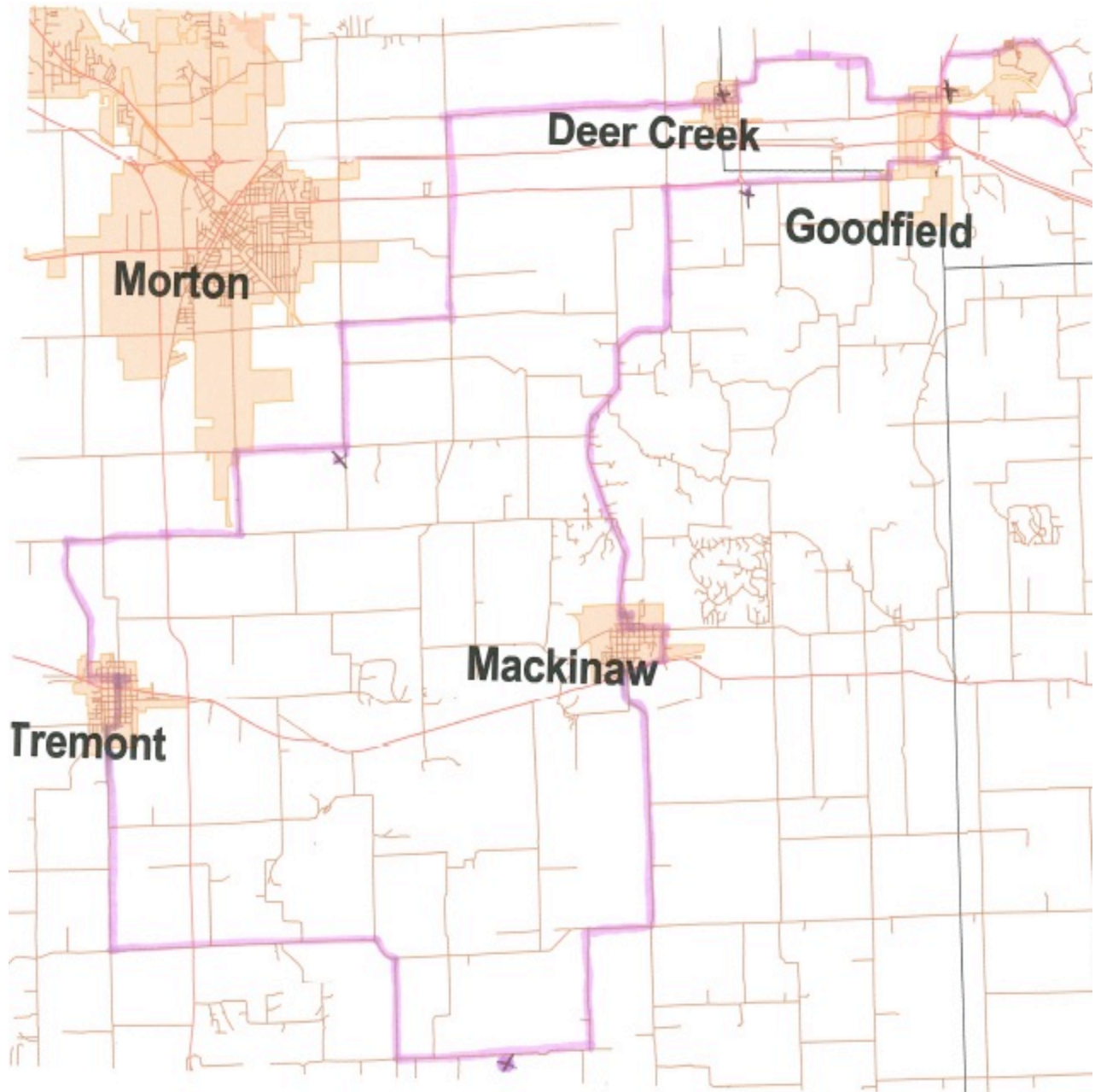
